# LISTENING SQUAWKS

## Listening Squawks

Frequency Monitoring SSR Codes (also known as Squawk Codes) are in use for aircraft flying in the vicinity of: Belfast Aldergrove; Edinburgh; Glasgow; Leeds Bradford; Doncaster Sheffield; Manchester; East Midlands; Birmingham; Farnborough; Luton and Stansted; Gatwick and London City; Southampton and Bournemouth. For details of the correct squawk and frequency see over.

### Points to remember

- Enter the appropriate listening squawk for the area, with Mode C if you have it
- Tune into the appropriate frequency and listen out, without transmitting
- Change back to 7000, with Mode C, if you have it, when leaving the area or changing frequency

### A listening squawk does NOT...

- Clear you into controlled airspace
- Mean that you are receiving any ATC service
- If you need a service from ATC, contact either the appropriate LARS frequency or London/Scottish Information as required
