


A Frequency Monitoring Code (FMC) is a unique code which shows air traffic control units who are equipped with radar that you are monitoring a specific frequency.

Before selecting an FMC, you should ensure that you are operating within the FMC area designated for the appropriate Air Traffic Service.

The appropriate frequency should then be selected, ensuring the volume on your radio is turned up, before entering the FMC into the transponder.

You must remain outside controlled and notified airspace and are not in receipt of an Air Traffic Service.

Solent FMC Area



Aircraft operating outside controlled airspace, the Lee-on-Solent ATZ and the Fleetlands ATZ but within the area shown with a black outline are encouraged to monitor Solent Radar on 120.230 MHz and select SSR code 7011.

Pilots operating outside controlled airspace but proximate to the Leeon-Solent ATZ are encouraged to obtain a service from Lee Information during its notified hours of operation to obtain relevant information to allow flights to be conducted safely.

Pilots operating outside controlled airspace but proximate to the Portsmouth/Fleetlands ATZ are encouraged to obtain a service from Fleetlands Information during its notified hours of operation.
