RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS: XXII COMMONWEALTH GAMES, BIRMINGHAM 2022 28 JULY - 9 AUGUST 2022

- 1** The XXII Commonwealth Games, Birmingham 2022, events will take place in Birmingham, West Midlands, during the period **28 July to 9 August 2022**. The Secretary of State for Transport has deemed it necessary in the interests of public safety and security to introduce the following Restriction of Flying Regulations under Article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016.

The times mentioned in this document are Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time.

- 2** **CHART AREA A:** Subject to paragraph 5, **between 0600 hours on 28 July 2022 and 0600 hours on 9 August 2022**, no aircraft is to fly below 4500 FT AMSL within the area:

- 3** **CHART AREA B:** Subject to paragraph 5, **between 2300 hours on 2 August 2022 and 2300 hours on 3 August 2022**, no aircraft is to fly below 4500 FT AMSL within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 3 NM whose centre is at 524503N 0015758W.

- 4** **CHART AREA C:** Subject to paragraph 5, **between 2300 hours on 3 August 2022 and 2300 hours on 4 August 2022**, no aircraft is to fly below 4500 FT AMSL within the area bounded by:

- 5** Paragraphs (2) to (4) do not apply to any aircraft:

- a) operating by or on behalf of:
- i. National Police Air Service;

- ii. the Helicopter Emergency Medical Service;
- iii. the Maritime and Coastguard Agency for the purpose of search and rescue only; or,
- iv. The Queens Helicopter Flight.

- b) flying in accordance with a permission of the ATCU at Birmingham International Airport which has been authorised by West Midlands Police Air Command Cell.
- c) flying in accordance with a permission issued by West Midlands Police Air Command Cell who may be contacted via cw_aircell@westmidlands.police.uk or via telephone number 07795-697884.

- 6** Pilots are reminded that unless flying in accordance with paragraph 5 above, the Restriction of Flying Regulations prohibit entry into the Restricted Area (Temporary) during the periods of activation.
- 7** This restriction also includes, any small balloon, any kite weighing not more than 2 KG any unmanned aircraft and any parachute including a parascending parachute and paramotor.
- 8** The times mentioned in paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 are Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC), which is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

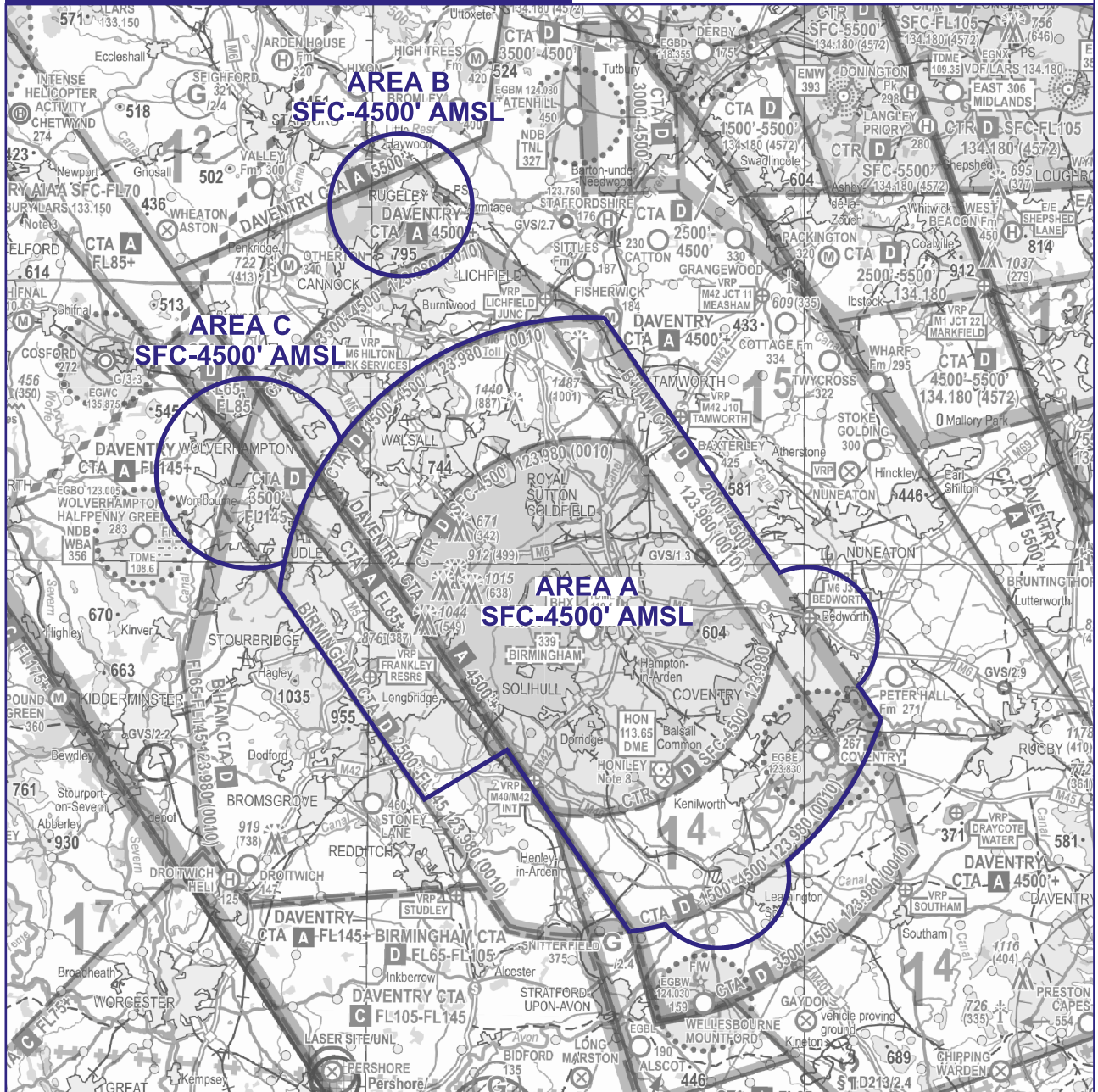
RESTRICTED AREAS (TEMPORARY) COMMONWEALTH GAMES BIRMINGHAM 2022
