
Frequency Monitoring Code (FMC)

A Frequency Monitoring Code (FMC) is a unique code which shows air traffic control units who are equipped with radar that you are monitoring a specific frequency.


Before selecting an FMC, you should ensure that you are operating within the FMC area designated for the appropriate Air Traffic Service.

The appropriate frequency should then be selected before entering the FMC into the transponder.

You must remain outside controlled and notified airspace except for the portion of the Manchester CTR designated as the Manchester Low Level Route where special procedures apply.



Manchester FMC Area



Pilots operating outside controlled airspace and outside of the Barton ATZ but within the area shown are encouraged to monitor Manchester Radar on 118.580 MHz and select SSR code 7366.

Aircraft intending to operate within the Manchester Low Level Route are required to monitor Manchester Radar and, where transponder equipped, select 7366. If the PIC is a solo student, then they must select 7367.

Pilots operating outside controlled airspace but proximate to the Barton ATZ are encouraged to obtain a service from Barton Information on 120.255 MHz during its notified hours of operation to obtain relevant information to allow its flights to be conducted safely. You must remain outside controlled and notified airspace and are not in receipt of an Air Traffic Service.
