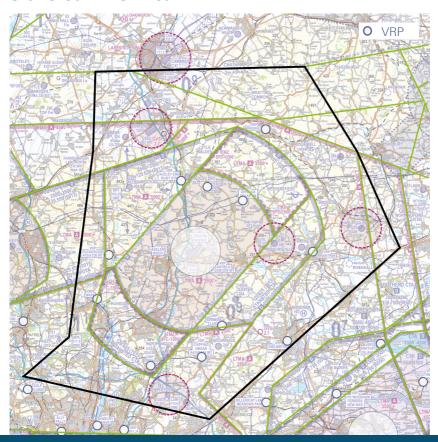

## Frequency Monitoring Code (FMC)

A Frequency Monitoring Code (FMC) is a unique code which shows air traffic control units who are equipped with radar that you are monitoring a specific frequency. Before selecting an FMC, you should ensure that you are operating within the FMC area designated for the appropriate Air Traffic Service. The appropriate frequency should then be selected before entering the FMC into the transponder. You must remain outside controlled and notified airspace and are not in receipt of an Air Traffic Service.

## Stansted FMC Guide



Aircraft operating outside controlled airspace and the Cambridge, Duxford, Andrewsfield, Earls Colne and Stapleford ATZs but within the area shown overleaf and are not utilising the LARS provided by Farnborough Radar or Southend Radar are encouraged to monitor Stansted Radar on 120.625 MHz and select SSR code 7013.

Pilots operating outside controlled airspace but proximate to the Cambridge ATZ or Duxford ATZ are encouraged to obtain a service from Cambridge Approach or Duxford Information, whichever is most appropriate, during the notified hours of operation to obtain relevant information to allow their flights to be conducted safely.

Pilots operating outside controlled airspace but proximate to the Andrewsfield ATZ, Earls Colne ATZ or Stapleford ATZ are encouraged to establish two-way communications with the relevant Air Ground Communication Service to obtain information to allow their flights to be conducted safely.
