

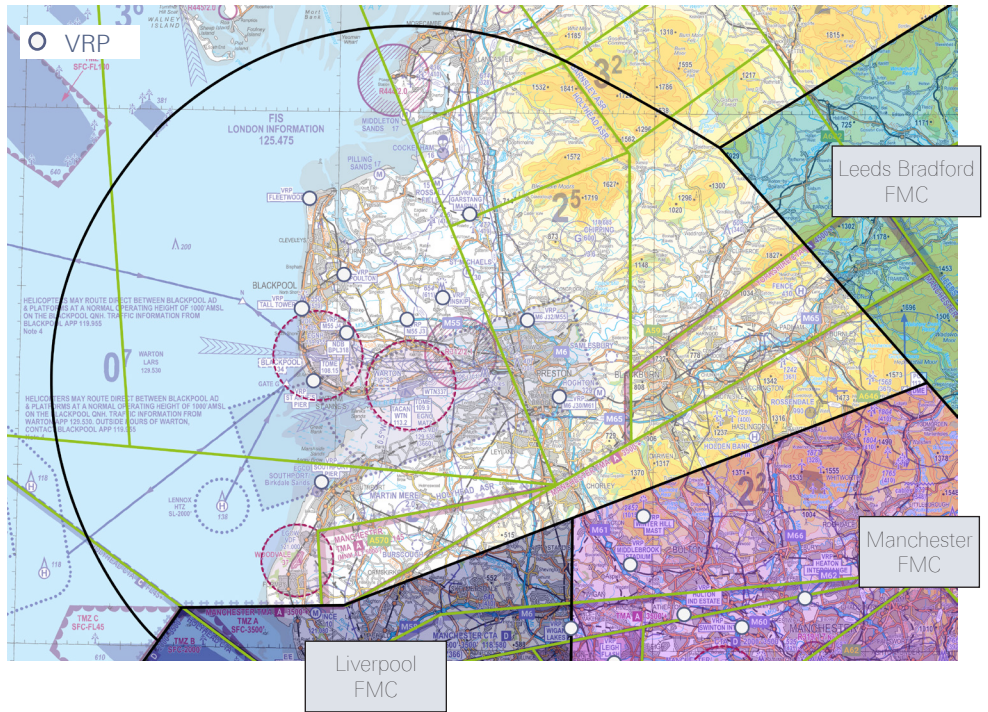
A Frequency Monitoring Code (FMC) is a unique code which shows air traffic control units who are equipped with radar that you are monitoring a specific frequency. Before selecting an FMC, you should ensure that you are operating within the FMC area designated for the appropriate Air Traffic Service.

The appropriate frequency should then be selected before entering the FMC into the transponder. You must remain outside controlled and notified airspace and are not in receipt of an Air Traffic Service. FMCs should only be used during the notified hours of operation of the nominated radar frequency.

# Warton FMC area



Pilots operating outside controlled airspace but within the Warton FMC area and not using the Lower Airspace Radar Service (LARS) provided by Warton Radar are encouraged to monitor Warton Radar on 129.530 MHz and select SSR code 3660.

Pilots operating outside controlled airspace but proximate to the Blackpool ATZ or Woodvale are encouraged to obtain a service from Blackpool Approach or Woodvale Information. Check the notified hours or operation before your flight.
